We invite you to visit the Cat Lady's Garden where we specialize in daylilies. Plan now for a daylily treat. We are an Official AHS Display Garden and will be open to the public from 8 A.M. until 4 P.M. on Saturday July 17th. You will see thousands of daylilies in the peak bloom season – a spectacular sight. Plus you can admire the latest introductions from the leading hybridizers as well as many old favorites. For those who have visited us before, please come again as we are continuing to improve our display. We have many of the newest on display and hundreds of fine container grown varieties for you to purchase. A portion from our sale of potted daylilies will be donated to help homeless cats and to help spay and neuter rescued cats. We will also accept donations of cat food for the shelter. Dry cat food (Nutro Max, Royal Canin, ProPlan or other premium foods) plus all kinds of canned cat food.

What Is An AHS Display Garden?

An American Hemerocallis Society Display Garden is established to display the very best daylily cultivars to the general public. Its purpose is to educate the visitor about modern daylilies and how they can be used effectively in landscapes.

In an approved AHS Display Garden, a visitor can view a large number and wide variety of labeled daylilies in a well-maintained garden setting. To obtain official AHS Display Garden status, certain criteria must be met:

- The owner must be a member of the AHS for two years or more to be eligible for a garden to be designated as an AHS Display Garden.
- Although the number of daylily cultivars is not set, the garden must include a wide variety of daylilies (i.e., diploids and tetraploids; old and new; full, round, and spiders; small, miniatures, and large flowers; and eyes and selfs) from a number of hybridizers.
- The garden must be well maintained (i.e., water, fertilizer, mulch, et cetera) and relatively free of weeds. The growing conditions and culture should show daylilies to their maximum potential.
- Plant markers should be maintained in good condition, with the name of both the cultivar and the hybridizer showing clearly. Date of registration is often included on the marker as well.
- The garden should be open to the public during bloom season.

DIRECTIONS

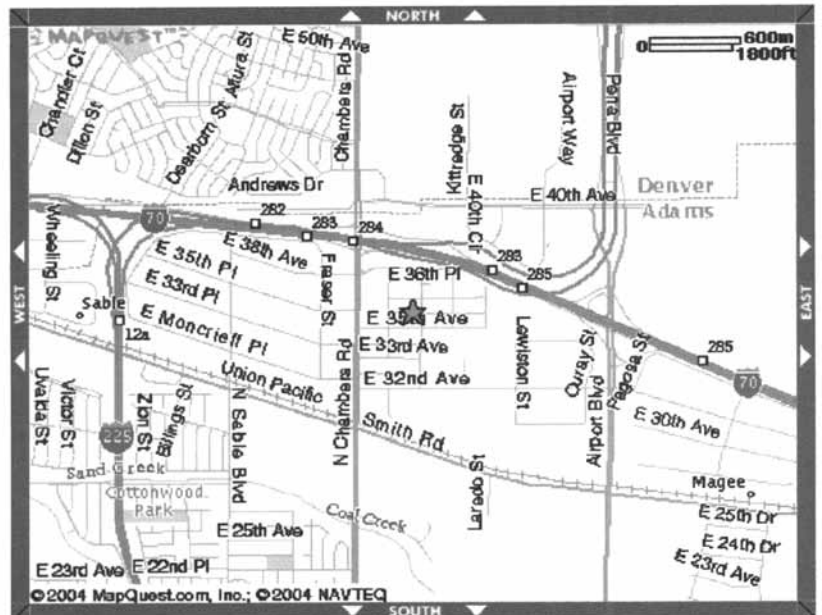
We are located near I-70 and Chambers Road in Aurora.

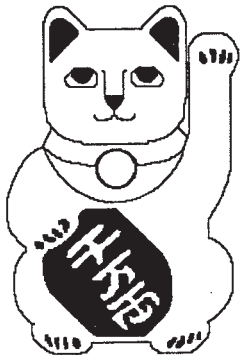
From I-70, take exit 283 (Chambers Road).
